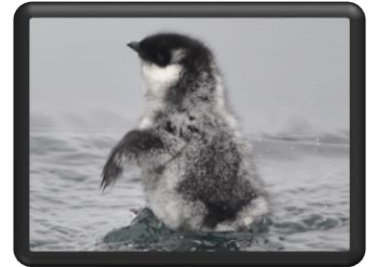

Laskeek Bay Conservation Society (LBCS) is a local organization involved in research and educational programs around conservation on Haida Gwaii. We offer 4 week field-intensive research and conservation internships* between May and July annually. * Our final internship of the summer includes 1 week working in our office in town

June 1 - June 29; June 29 - July 27**



INTERN ACTIVITIES

- Collecting and managing field biology data (e.g. weighing fledglings)
- Identifying a large variety of birds, marine mammals, and plants
- Using low impact research methods for a variety of marine and terrestrial ecology projects
- Delivering environmental education programs to local youth
- Living and working in a remote coastal field biology camp, sharing the duties of day-to-day tasks



REQUIREMENTS

- Recent graduate OR entering 3rd or 4th year of Biology, Resource Management, Environmental Science, or a related undergraduate program
- Highly motivated & interested in research on seabirds and coastal ecology
- Physically fit, able to work long days outdoors in remote, rugged terrain
- Priority given to candidates with first aid and boating experience

PROGRAM COST

\$1200 for a 4 week internship includes food, lodging and transportation to and from Queen Charlotte and Field Station (transportation to/from Haida Gwaii not included)

Internships can be **accredited (3 credit 200 or 400 level undergraduate research/directed study course) **through SFU** (additional costs apply). Inquire with us when applying for more details.
